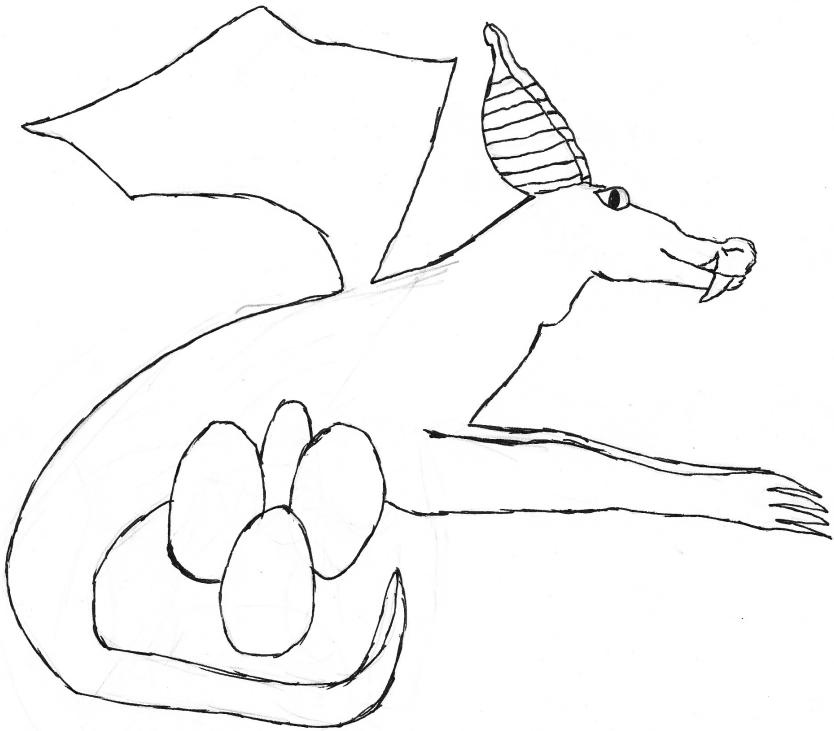

### **Finance Committee:**

Update on Feast bid by Gwen the Potter. First Lutheran Church of Poulsbo Christian Center will not work out, they already had events scheduled on the weekends of December. Will try to find new location.

### **Baronial Steward:**

1. Next event in the queue for access to Baronial Storage will be June Faire. If you know you will need items from Baronial Storage to support June Faire, now is the time to start making your lists and speaking to the SCA Coordinator (Dame Madrun) or to the Autocrat (Arontius). Lady Diana Cartier will be gathering volunteers and organizing the actual physical pack-out and return of material from Baronial Storage. Please plan on assisting if you can. The more hands available, the faster the process goes.

2. June Faire U-Haul Loading will be Wednesday, June 3rd. We'll start at the UNHEATED Storage Unit (at the corner of Waaga Way and Fairgrounds Road) starting at 6PM. We will also need help in unloading the U-Haul back into the Storage Units on Sunday, June 7th. Everyone is tired from a long weekend, but the more hands we can get to travel south with us to unload the faster and easier it is for everyone. Please put this on your reminder list and plan to help if you can.

3. If you need to get into the Storage Units for material at any other time, please contact the Steward at least several days prior to the need (the sooner the better). 'Instant Access' is rarely possible. Contact Arontius at <arontius@comcast.net> if

you need access or if you have any questions. Either myself or the Steward Deputy (Dame Madrun) can meet with you at the Storage Unit(s) depending on schedule.

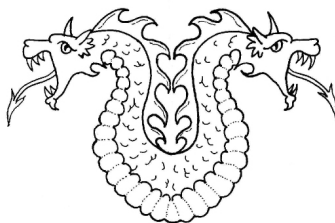

**Scribal Guild:** See Baronial Scribe report.

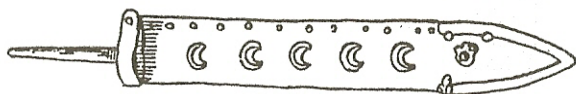

June 13 24

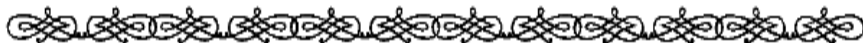

#### **1. General Notes -**

\* Information (schedules, points-of-contact, reservation and camping procedures, etc.) is flowing to the web-site as fast as we can get it to Aelianora for posting. Same with missing information. If you can't find information you think ought to be available there, please ask and we'll get it rounded up and posted. \* SCHEDULE FOR SET-UP ON THURSDAY, JUNE 4TH: 9AM-NOON - ONLY THOSE INVOLVED WITH LAY-OUT OF LINES PLEASE. 1PM - 6PM - SET-UP OF INFRASTRUCTURE. THIS IS WHEN WE'LL NEED THE MOST HELP. 6PM - DUSK - SET-UP OF PERSONAL ENCAMPMENT FOR THOSE WHO ASSISTED DURING THE DAY OR WILL BE PART OF EARLY FRIDAY CREW. THURSDAY SET-UP POLICY WILL BE POSTED IN FACEBOOK / E-LIST CLOSER TO JUNE FAIRE. PLEASE TALK TO SOMEONE ON THE BOARD BEFORE YOU ARRIVE ON THURSDAY!!!

\* We need a Volunteer Coordinator again. We had a couple of people who were ready to step up to perform this, but life happened and we are once again looking for someone to perform this valuable function. At this point we could really use the help of someone who can, on the fly over the weekend, when volunteers are urgently needed for any particular issue, make the rounds in encampments and gatherings and gather willing people and send them to where help is urgently needed. \* Our Prize Coordinator, THL Adelheide Leeuwin, has been working hard to gather and advertise prizes for June Faire. \* Pre-registration will close at the middle of May. Pre-registration guarantees space set-aside for households and large groups and helps speed the check-in at gate. Please consider doing this. \* Don't forget that there is a wedding scheduled for Friday. The Bowl will be off-limits to allow for parking at the wedding (which is expecting 'several hundred guests'). We will not be using the Bowl for camping this year. It will be VIP and Handicapped Parking for the weekend. PLEASE HELP US MAKE SURE THE ROAD DOWN INTO THE BOWL IS NOT BLOCKED WITH PARKED CARS OVER THE WEEKEND.

\* We could really use someone to take care of the sandwich board road signage for the weekend. It is an easy job that takes about an hour on Thursday and Sunday to complete. If you can help, please contact Arontius.

\* We could really use help in putting up the June Faire advertising signage at the Poulsbo Activities sign (the three-part LARGE sign at the entrance to Poulsbo). This signage goes up the Sunday before June Faire. Please contact Arontius if you can help.

\* Finally. We do want to hear from you. Any questions for the Board? Want to get involved in the planning process? Contact the Chairman, Arontius, at <[arontius@comcast.net](mailto:arontius@comcast.net)>.

## 2. SCA Coordinator (Madrun) -

\* Lay-out of major activities close to complete.

\* Martiallate activity schedules are close to complete.

\* Family Activities will have exciting plans for the weekend. This year we will have the talents of Dame Angharad as well as the support of the Glymm Mere Family Activities Coordinators.

\* A&S Presentations are being gathered into a Master Listing, with scheduled 'tours' to show-case talents and skills. Exciting plans in the works.

\* Dame Madrun is speaking to every Baronial Officer to ascertain their need for space and materials at June Faire (and any special needs). Anything you can do in preparation for this would be appreciated. Do you need a pavilion? How much of a foot-print of land do you need? Where do you need to be located? Do you need supplies (batteries, rope, ???)?

\* If you want to be part of the Baronial 'Roman Encampment' (AND WHO WOULDN'T WANT TO BE!!!!), you should pre-register to ensure that you are placed on the map for the Baronial Encampment on the Hilltop. THL Myrick will be working with Kloe to wrangle the Baronial Roman Encampment.

\* Wrangling of pavilions (who gets what) in process. If you are running an activity or office at June Faire and are unsure of where you'll be and under what canvas, please make sure to check in with Madrun to find out and make arrangements.

3. Town Liaison / Contracts (Inga and Diomedes) - Work continuing on establishment of regular site contracts.

- \* Shuttle service reserved and scheduled.

- \* Working on reserving straw bales.

- \* Working on reserving tables and having them delivered / picked-up from site.

4. Gate Coordinator (Francisca) - June Faire pre-registration form is LIVE and available on the June Faire web-site, <<http://www.dragonslaire.org/events/june-faire.php>>. REMINDER: Pre-registration will filter through the Glymm Mere exchequer. Keep this in mind when writing your checks ("SCA, Inc.; Barony of Glymm Mere"). Also note that we are still requiring those large groups who want to reserve space together to pre-register.

- \* A Gate Class will be scheduled for anyone who would like to take an active role in running a shift at gate. Most likely a class will be scheduled for Thursday, June 4th, or early Friday morning, June 5th. An e-mail and message will be distributed as soon as this schedule is finalized.

5. Marketplace Coordinator (Countess Elisabeth) -

- \* Marketplace is in process of being mapped.

- \* Complete listing of merchants in June Faire Marketplace posted on the June Faire Web-Page. Currently approximately thirty-three merchants and five food vendors.

6. Public Relations (Ataliana 'Talia') -

- \* Contacts with all usual advertising (local, regional, SCA, etc.) in process.

- \* Road-side and large visibility signage being created to support June Faire.

- \* Call for items to be displayed in usual Sylvan Way Kitsap Library Display should come out shortly. Talia is making the arrangements and will need help in setting up the display. Please contact her if you can help.

- \* Advertising flyers for June Faire XXXIII now available (MANY DIFFERENT TYPES). Please grab some to post wherever you can. This would be greatly appreciated.

7. Continuity Coordinators (Marquessa Laurellen and Gwenllyn) -

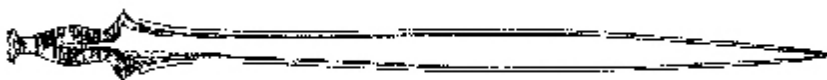
