Finance Committee:

Update on Feast bid by Gwen the Potter. New location found, at Silverdale Lutheran Church in Silverdale. There will be a no-fee Ithra tied to the feast. Cost of site is \$750, with an \$80 stipend to be paid the individual who will open the hall and lock it up afterward, plus a \$150 cleaning deposit (refundable if we keep the place clean

and undamaged). Site fee will be \$10 per person, feast fee \$8 per person. 17 and under free for site fee, there will be a discounted fee for children who are eating the feast. Off board will be available. Feast will be capped at 100, there are about 128 chairs, so that is our limit for sitting down.

A \$500 donation to the Kingdom Feast was approved, to help cover the cost for the Dragon's Laire Remove.

Richard Kelso has agreed to take on the Recording Secretary duties, in addition to being Deputy Branch Treasurer. Gwen the Potter (Wendy McComb) is stepping down, as of the October 2015 meeting.

Baronial Steward:

- 1. Re-organization and inventory of Unheated Baronial Storage Unit still in process. My Deputy (Madrun) and I will be making this happen throughout the remainder of the year. - 2. We're almost moved out of the Heated Storage Unit. The two main items left are the Filing Cabinet and the Wooden Rack. Space still needs to be made for both within the Unheated Unit. We will make this happen the weekend after September Crown, and then move the remaining items over before the end of September. After equipment comes back home from Last Chance, we'll work quickly to organize enough to be able to fit Gold Key into the Unit. At that point we'll methodically go through and inventory what is present, with an eye towards disposing of equipment that is broken, missing components, or has no conceivable use any longer in the Barony.
- 3. Initial list of equipment needs for Last Chance in hand. Updated list will be received in time to support having this equipment available for easy pack-out and load sometime during the week of Last Chance. If you have equipment needs for Last Chance, please make sure you contact THL Myrick and THL Andromacha as soon as possible to get those items added to the list.

Heavy Armored

Heavy practice continues on Tuesday evenings at the VFW Hall in Silverdale. Practice is concurrent with the Baronial social, from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. Some fighters choose to optimize the time by arriving early to armor up and get ready.

Rapier

Rapier practices continue at the VFW Hall on Tuesday evenings in conjunction with the Baronial Social. Interest is good and we continue to draw new and guest fighters to our practices.

Archery

Archery practices have been packed. We have had several new people come out to see what we are doing in August. The range has been well attended by many of our Baronial Archers.

Practices continue on Wednesday Nights from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm at the VFW. Range Set-up is between 5:15 pm and 5:30 pm. The date for Yule is Saturday, December 5, 2015. Site will open for set up at 8


