After your first login you will be required to change your password. Please DO NOT use a password that you use on another account! Also, it's probably a good idea to use a password that you won't mind sharing with the good gentle who will take up your office after you, when the time comes. So, you know, don't use your bank info or your kindergarten nickname unless you'd like to share that.

Once you have your account set up, please use it to send me an email at webminister@dragonslaire.org or DragonsLaire.Webminister@antir.org -- both of these go to the same place now. If you have trouble setting up your account, email me at one of those

addresses and I will see if I can help. If you have questions, comments, or interesting cookie recipes, please email me at one of those addresses. If you have personal insults, please email me at nobody@nowhere.nil

I'm sure some of you would like to copy or move some of your emails over to your new account. I will share guides for this sort of thing shortly, using both the DL email list and the DL Facebook page.

*Youth Armored Combat (YACs)** – this position requires a background check.

*Youth and Family Activities (YAFA)** – We are putting this position into abeyance. Dragon's Laire youth and children are mostly preteens and young children. The lack of age diversity means that it is very difficult to plan activities for age groups, and then engage them in those activities.

We will still plan for youth and family activities, but they will no longer be coordinated through a designated officer.

* Positions that work with youth must meet additional requirements, including a background check and additional supervision. Adult participation in youth activities must meet the "Two Deep" rule, meaning that two adults must be present for youth activities. The second adult need not participate, but instead may simply be present, and must not be of the same household as the first adult, nor be the parent of the child.
