- His Excellency submitted a bid for \$300 to compensate the creator of the new Heavy Champions sword who is also providing an unasked for scabbard. The original deal was 2 years of June Faire fees which the scabbard alone would cover the cost of. Approved.

Open Officer Positions

*Youth Armored Combat (YACs)** – this position requires a background check.

** Positions that work with youth must meet additional requirements, including a background check and additional supervision. Adult participation in youth activities must meet the "Two Deep" rule, meaning that two adults must be present for youth activities. The second adult need not participate, but instead may simply be present, and must not be of the same household as the first adult, nor be the parent of the child.
