We had a busy month of June. Almost all of our supplies went out to June Faire. We had 2 items come back damaged, the Big Baronial Pavilion has a hole in the top and one of the lean-tos suffered a catastrophic failure due to the wind. Everything else was returned in working order, though not returned in the pre-marked bins. Because of this there will be a major rearrangement of the storage unit in order to get everything back where it belongs.

The Archery Pavilion was checked out and taken to ATWW as a camp shade for the Dragon's Laire Encampment. It was returned in the same condition it left.

The PFDA was delivered to ATWW and was taken to the West via the SCA courier system. It shall have a new home with people who lost items during one of the many fires over the last few years.

The Baronial brazier was checked out to ATWW Cooks Play Date and was returned via myself in good condition.

There will be poles painted and bags made for all the pavilions over the winter. Everything will be color coded. Once we have canvas there will be a call to machines to help sew up totes for all the pavilions.
