#### **New Business:**

- THL Ciar, as Seneschal, has requested \$200 pre-permission if the Baronial Polling needs to switch to Absentee Ballot Polling versus the currently planned In Person Polling with opt in Absentee based on what happens with the coronavirus. As of 12<sup>th</sup> Night 2020, the Barony had 147 paid members, which means approximately 300 stamps, 300 envelopes, address labels, and the polling forms. Approved.
