Finance Meeting Notes:

New Business:

- Baronial Chairs, Master Arion. Approved \$1000 for 2 chairs from Du Puy Creations for 2 of the Glastonbury style. One will be done in walnut and the other cherry with a middle chair panel in yellow and the dragon from the populace badge in relief on the back.
- New cushions will need to be made, possibly cannibalized from the old ones but a bid for those will come in the future once we know dimensions and cost of supplies.

FYI:

THL Kloe will be entering a bid next month to commission THL Bera-Skalla for 3d printed stamps representing groups and activities for use in stamping and labeling Baronial property (canvas bags for pavilions) and the production of dags. It's expected to be \$160 but firm numbers and badge count next month.

Additionally, there will be some behind-the-scenes work based on feedback from Alicia du Bois -- for example, she wants all An Tir webministers to use a specific security plugin with specific settings.
