Craftsmanship:

How difficult was the project to complete? Consider the tools and processes used and rate the complexity of the project.

Simple project, relatively easy to do Project required a medium level of technical ability and craftsmanship Complex project required a high level of technical ability, craftsmanship and/or multiple facets

Thoughts to consider:

Writing and Documentation:

How well does the author describe the historical context of the entry and/or process? Who made the item? Who used the item? What are the known/possible uses of the item? When was the item used? Where (geographically and/or socially) the item used? How was the item made?

Note the quality of sources consulted. Consider the Bibliography/References. Does the author make a good critical assessment of source quality? Is the discussion of the topic clearly written and easy to follow?

Basic writing, documentation, and Bibliography/References. Average writing, documentation, and Bibliography/References. Advanced writing, documentation and Bibliography/References.
