a. Archery office – Request to purchase two Eager tex mats, 129.99 + shipping. 367.86 total for purchase and shipping. Bull dog mats are 60\$, try to sell for 25\$ each to help offset the cost of the new mats. William David Peters (AKA Arion Wanderer) suggested to purchase 3. Approved to purchase three. Waiting for Check request Form. Check reconciled September 28, 2021 and sold Two Bull dog mats \$50.00 reconciled September 27, 2021. Two additional targets left for sale. **Waiting for final sales.**

b. Purchase of three Baronial Day Shades- Amanda Zeitler (AKA HE Kloe of Thira)

Purchase of three Baronial Day Shades: Canvas was received in June. Poles, ropes, and stakes to be manufactured / acquired and Day Shades assembled for storage. Her Excellency Kloe is managing this effort at the moment. Several people volunteered to assist in this work. M'Lord Kamar (MKA Raymond Hicks) volunteered the use of an Industrial Sewing Machine for the manufacture of Canvas Bags in which

to store Baronial Owned Equipment. If you have equipment, or time, you can donate for this cause, please contact Her Excellency Kloe. Susan Levitt purchased new rope. Reimbursement for supplies and a one-time travel allowance approved by the DLFC on 04/12/2021 to Susan Levitt. What is next for the project? Left to purchase: poles and pins, and stakes. Hold on acquiring poles due to the increased cost of lumber. Focus on acquiring stakes. Needs physical help to assess tents and number of stakes needed. David Meyers (AKA Thangbrandr) to submit a bid for pole pins and tent stakes. Approved. Reimbursement made 02/01/22. Dinning fly poles bid - Lucy Submitted bid for poles. Approved for purchase of materials. Awaiting reimbursement request. **Bags project will be re-visited after June Faire.**

As of this report I had not seen the final tally of expenditurs versus income, but my expectation is the Barony lost a little money. However, I heard many words of joy from those in attendance. So I will still call the event a success from that standpoint. This event was quite literally two years of effort, with many delays which were frustrating. But we

persevered and made it happen. In closing I would like to once again thank my Chief Cook and Arranger of the Feast, Her Excellency Elisabeth de Rossignol. The Feast was wonderful in every way. I sincerely appreciated her wisdom, her insight, her intelligence, and patience with every direction I took, and most especially her tenacity to keeping the faith that eventually the Feast would happen. 2. September Crown. Location: Kitsap County Fairgrounds; 1200 Fairgrounds Rd. NW; Bremerton, WA 98311. Dates: September 2-5, 2022. A Facebook Planning Page has been established. Arontius of Bygelswade and Ciar ingen Fiachnae (Co-Stewards) have met and have finalized the Volunteers to date. We are holding off on finalizing the Fairgrounds 'User Agreement' until the conclusion of June Faire so we can incorporate 'Lessons Learned' into that Agreement. The Staff of the Fairgrounds is quite new in their positions, and they are learning how to work the system at the same time we are. So much learning is happening on both sides of the table. We are slowly filling necessary positions. We have a dedicated Gate Lead, Mistress Etiennette (Former Kingdom Exchequer). We have a possible Camp Minister, with a Team being built, that should finalize by June Faire at the latest. Pre-Registration is being targeted to open early in June. HL Pernell is our Pre-Registration Coordinator and is taking this time to learn every aspect of online invoicing (Thank You, Pernell). The first planning meeting of the Event Team will happen in person (with a Zoom line available) at the VFW Hall on Thursday, May 5th, starting at 6PM. If you would like to get involved now in planning and taking part in this event, please speak to either Arontius or Ciar and we'll get you involved. June Faire takes priority at the moment, but we'll be steadily working to organize our efforts for a truly magnificent September Crown in order to host all of An Tir within the borders of Dragon's Laire.
