Minted Melon Salad

Good Day and Well Met Good Gentle!

Too hot to cook? Need a refreshing dish? Here's one that is simple and cooling.

This simple melon salad comes from a letter written about healthful eating by a sixth century Roman doctor known by the name Anthimus. Our errant doctor had gotten himself in some political trouble in Rome and headed out into Gaul where he settled into a court position far from Rome. Most of the entries in the letter list the properties of a food and comment on its health benefits, but there are a few recipes, or instructions that can lead to a recipe tucked here and there. While most reflect Roman practices, there is some commentary on the habits of his Gaulish hosts. See Anthimus; on the Observance of Foods, de observatione ciborum, Edited and Translated by Mark Grant, Prospect Books, 2007 for more.

The original notes call for using the seeds of the melon as well as the flesh, which is not something you might want to do with most modern melons, however, I did come across a vintage melon-cucumber a few years ago, which is the perfect choice, if I could find it again, for this recipe.



Minted Melon Salad

One melon (I prefer a honeydew, but choose whatever you like), peeled, seeded, and cut into bite sized pieces

Sprinkle with a little vinegar, use red wine, balsamic, or if you can get it, raspberry or some other fruit vinegar.

Add in chopped fresh mint or if the leaves are small leave whole. Toss and allow to marinate for a short time before serving.

If melons are well ripened, their flesh is particularly recommended mixed with their own seeds, and this is better than if they are eaten on their own. If, as people do, they are eaten like this with diluted vinegar and a sprinkling of pennyroyal, they are good for healthy people. For those who have problem of the kidneys or bladder, diluted vinegar is not suitable, because vinegar when plain is fairly injurious to the kidneys and bladder. And is not good for the liver.

Note: pennyroyal is an herb in the mint family but is no longer considered safe for consumption, especially for pregnant women.

OFFICERS WANTED

Exchequer: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Guiote de Bourgogne!

The Exchequer is the treasurer of the Barony and is responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within the Barony as described by the Kingdom and Society Exchequer handbooks.

Leads the Finance Committee and moderates the Finance Committee meetings. This is a Kingdom warranted position, which is required to send quarterly reports to a designated Kingdom Officer.

- a. Oversee the Steward, the Librarian, and the Finance Committee Clerk.
- b. Act as advisor to the June Faire Committee.
- c. Attend regional Exchequer symposiums, as able, in order to stay up to date on changes to law and policy. These trainings may be in person or via video conferencing.
- d. It is not a requirement that someone holding this Office have a degree or previous modern life job training in this type of position.

Thrown Weapons Deputy: Please speak with Lady Crystal or Sir Andras if you are interested.

The Thrown Weapons Officer is responsible for the conduct of Society-legal target thrown weapons within the Barony. This is a Kingdom warranted position which requires quarterly reporting. The duties and responsibilities are described in the An Tir Book of Target and the SCA Marshal's Handbook.

- a. Run the throwing range for weekly practice, as weather permits, as well as at Baronial events and Baronial hosted Kingdom events.
- b. Report scores within the time range stipulated by the Kingdom.

- c. Maintain loaner gear in appropriate condition and submit an inventory to the Steward annually as requested.
- d. Make monthly reports at the Baronial business meeting and submit quarterly reports to the Kingdom Deputy Marshal for Thrown Weapons.

Chatelaine: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Halldora Bjorn.

The Chatelain(e) is a Kingdom warranted Officer position and is the primary point of contact for newcomers to the Barony. They submit quarterly reports to their Kingdom Officer. Chatelain(e)s may have multiple deputies.

Other duties include:

- a. Setup and arrange for volunteers to be in the Chatelain(e) booth at June Faire.
- b. Maintain Gold Key including checking out and in items as well as repairs and replacements as needed. This task may be assigned to a deputy.
- c. Coordinating and scheduling demonstrations for schools, civic groups, and other interested organizations.

Webminister: Looking for a Technical Deputy, please speak with HL Máenach na Cailled.

I'm seeking a deputy to assist with technical duties related to the office such as maintenance of our Wordpress website (updating plugins, etc.), managing our email forwarding accounts, and keeping our domain name registrations current. The exact list of duties is flexible, and I'm happy to provide any assistance and training you might want. If you think you might be interested in becoming the next Webminister, this would be a great way to explore the idea. Thank you!

Lists: Please speak with Sir Andras if you are interested.

The Minister of Lists is responsible for running tournaments at Baronial events, which will include Baronial Championships and may include Crown Tourneys.

- a. Maintain and stock the Lists box with appropriate forms as needed.
- b. Provide an inventory to the Baronial Steward annually, as requested.
- c. Make monthly reports at the Baronial business meeting and submit quarterly reports to the Kingdom Deputy Marshal for Lists
- d. At Tournaments:
 - Confirm that all combatants have fighter authorization cards.
 - Arrange and record the pairing of fighters at tournaments and demonstrations.
 - Compile a roster of fighters in their area with a note on the qualifications of each.
 - See that combat waivers are brought to and used at all functions which might involve

fighting (armored combat, combat archery, rapier combat, or youth armored combat).

• Assist the Kingdom List Minister at Kingdom events as available, work in conjunction and cooperation with the marshals and heralds to ensure a smoothly run event.

Games Minister: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Lucy!

It is the responsibility of the Games Minister to promote, teach, and support the practice of playing medieval games and pastimes. Games Ministers are encouraged to host activities at Social and Baronial events and are supported if they choose to pursue hosting medieval game nights.

Other duties include:

- a. Maintain, and inventory the Baronial game supply.
- b. Provide the updated inventory to the Steward in January.

Golden Dragon Pursuivant (Herald): Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Owain!

The Herald acts as the voice of the Crown and of the Crown's Representatives, the Coronet. The Dragon's Laire Baronial Herald uses the title of Golden Dragon Pursuivant. This is a Kingdom Warranted position, which is required to send quarterly reports to a designated Kingdom Officer.

a) Provide heraldic services to the Barony including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry. The Baronial Herald is not required to be an expert in all areas but should know who to call upon to provide the services.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: Looking for replacement Officer, please speak with Master Arontius or Marquesa Laurellen!

The Minister of Arts and Sciences is a Kingdom warranted position responsible for reporting quarterly to the Kingdom Officer. They are also responsible for fostering the practice of period arts and sciences within the Barony, including participation in the Dragon's Laire Scholars Program. Duties include:

- a. Organize and support the annual Arts & Sciences presentation and Championships, Bardic presentations and Championships, and Scholars program presentations.
- b. Schedule and oversee A&S play days, which are typically held in April and late October/early November.
- c. Organize and support A&S and Bardic activities at other Baronial events and Socials.
- d. Recruit and support deputies to assist with tasks and projects as well as the Games Minister position.

You can also speak with the Marquesa Laurellen about any position or consider asking about becoming a Deputy!

i. Purchase of three Baronial Day Shades: Canvas was received in June. Poles, ropes, and stakes to be manufactured / acquired and Day Shades assembled for storage. Her Excellency Kloe is managing this effort at the moment. Several people volunteered to assist in this work. M'Lord Kamar (MKA Raymond Hicks) volunteered the use of an Industrial Sewing Machine for the manufacture of Canvas Bags in which to store Baronial Owned Equipment. If you have equipment, or time, you can donate for this cause, please contact Her Excellency Kloe. Susan Levitt purchased new rope. Reimbursement for supplies and a one-time travel allowance approved by the DLFC on 04/12/2021 to Susan Levitt. What is next for the project? Left to purchase: poles and pins, and stakes. Hold on acquiring poles due to the increased cost of lumber. Focus on acquiring stakes. Needs physical help to assess tents and number of stakes needed. David Meyers (AKA Thangbrandr) to submit a bid for pole pins and tent stakes. Approved. Reimbursement made 02/01/22. Dining fly poles bid - Lucy Submitted bid for poles. Approved for purchase of materials. Waiting for reimbursement request. Bag project will re-visit after June Faire. Monthly Canton Archery Marshal's Report for the Proposed Incipient Canton of Misty Ridge Marshal Fearghus MacCulloch, submitted June 28, 2024:

We have submitted the paperwork to become an Incipient Canton and are waiting to hear from the kingdom about our status. Since we are not an official branch yet we have not held official practices. There have been no injuries at the practices that we have not held.

The question of why we cannot have SCA official practices has been raised yet again. A group discussion with the Baron, Baroness, Baronial Seneschal, Canton Seneschal and myself has started regarding the matter. I presented my findings and emails from the Kingdom Seneschal and the Kingdom Deputy Seneschal stating that we cannot have official practices yet. The only viable option that I presented is that I would need to be made a Baronial officer and then could hold baronial archery practice in the proposed canton. To do this, the Customary Officer Policy of the Barony would need to be changed to allow someone who is not a member of the Barony to hold office. Approval of this proposal needs to be obtained from the Kingdom Seneschal before the process can begin.
