

Receipts with Rycheza

A Newly Minted Pair: A Roman Cucumber Salad and Sikanjabîn for a cooling drink

With the hot weather as inspiration, this month's column bring you a couple of cooling dishes featuring mint. Mint was often used in the capacity of a sweetener, as it was in the Minted Melon Salad previously featured in this column, and also in more savory dishes such as the paring of mint jelly with roast lamb we see today.

Our Roman Cucumber Salad comes out of the Roman manuscript *de re coquinaria*. This cookbook hails at least the fourth century and some scholars point to earlier sources reaching possibly into the first century CE. Although attributed to the famed Roman gourmand Apicius, it is unlikely he was directly associated with the work, but rather his name became attached to it as a sort of endorsement a la the use of the fictional Betty Crocker in our own time.

Roman Minted Cucumber Salad

One cucumber- sliced (I generally leave the peel on, but you could peel the cucumber, or cut it in chunks, spears or any other way your heart desires.)

¼ cup red wine vinegar

1 tbsp honey

½ tsp fish sauce (available in the Asian section) Or substitute salt to taste.

6 fresh mint leaves, finely sliced. *

Combine all ingredients and let marinate, garnish with more mint, serve chilled or at room temp.4-6 servings

*Tip: a great way to cut up the mint is a process called chiffonade. Rinse and dry the mint leaves, stack them and roll into a cylinder, slice across the leaves with a sharp knife. This gives you long thin shreds of mint and keeps the chopping process neat.

One mea culpa to add here, I find that for some obscure reason I have omitted the pepper called for in the original. Pepper (black or perhaps long pepper) was a great favorite in Roman cookery and used in recipes both savory and sweet. Please feel free to add in a much as you like.

Our second featured recipe is not my own but as a great favorite across the Known World, I include it here: While this is a modern recipe, Sikanjabîn is a flavored syrup originating in Arabic manuscripts presented as medicinal recipes for treating a variety of ailments. Today we use it as the foundation for cooling drinks, diluting it with cold water to taste. It could also be combined with hot water as in the original recipe quoted below.

Simple Mint Sikanjabîn

4 cups sugar

2 1/2 cups water

1 cup wine vinegar

Handful of fresh mint or other herbs or spices.

Dissolve sugar in water over med high heat; when it comes to a boil add vinegar. Simmer 1/2 hour. Add a handful of mint, remove from fire, let cool. Strain out mint. Dilute the resulting syrup to taste with ice water. The syrup stores without refrigeration.

I have done this with a variety of flavorings from lemon to various herbs. Try experimenting with herbs like basil and lemon balm.

An original recipe from An Anonymous Andalusian Cookbook of the 13th Century

Syrup of Simple Sikanjabîn (Oxymel)

Translated by Charles Perry

Take a ratl of strong vinegar and mix it with two ratls of sugar, and cook all this until it takes the form of a syrup. Drink an ûqiya of this with three of hot water when fasting: it is beneficial for fevers of jaundice, and calms jaundice and cuts the thirst, since sikanjabîn syrup is beneficial in phlegmatic fevers: make it with six ûqiyas of sour vinegar for a ratl of honey and it is admirable.

Keep cool and keep cooking.

OFFICERS WANTED

Exchequer: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Guiote de Bourgogne!

The Exchequer is the treasurer of the Barony and is responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within the Barony as described by the Kingdom and Society Exchequer handbooks.

Leads the Finance Committee and moderates the Finance Committee meetings. This is a Kingdom warranted position, which is required to send quarterly reports to a designated Kingdom Officer.

- a. Oversee the Steward, the Librarian, and the Finance Committee Clerk.
- b. Act as advisor to the June Faire Committee.
- c. Attend regional Exchequer symposiums, as able, in order to stay up to date on changes to law and policy. These trainings may be in person or via video conferencing.
- d. It is not a requirement that someone holding this Office have a degree or previous modern life job training in this type of position.

Webminister: Looking for a Technical Deputy, please speak with HL Máenach na Cailled.

I'm seeking a deputy to assist with technical duties related to the office such as maintenance of our Wordpress website (updating plugins, etc.), managing our email forwarding accounts, and keeping our domain name registrations current. The exact list of duties is flexible, and I'm happy to provide any assistance and training you might want. If you think you might be interested in becoming the next Webminister, this would be a great way to explore the idea. Thank you!

Lists: Please speak with Honorable Lady Furia "Dammit" Dommitia if you are interested.

The Minister of Lists is responsible for running tournaments at Baronial events, which will include Baronial Championships and may include Crown Tourneys.

- a. Maintain and stock the Lists box with appropriate forms as needed.
- b. Provide an inventory to the Baronial Steward annually, as requested.
- c. Make monthly reports at the Baronial business meeting and submit quarterly reports to the Kingdom Deputy Marshal for Lists
- d. At Tournaments:
 - Confirm that all combatants have fighter authorization cards.
 - Arrange and record the pairing of fighters at tournaments and demonstrations.
 - Compile a roster of fighters in their area with a note on the qualifications of each.
 - See that combat waivers are brought to and used at all functions which might involve fighting (armored combat, combat archery, rapier combat, or youth armored combat).
 - Assist the Kingdom List Minister at Kingdom events as available, work in conjunction and cooperation with the marshals and heralds to ensure a smoothly run event.

Games Minister: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Lucy!

It is the responsibility of the Games Minister to promote, teach, and support the practice of playing medieval games and pastimes. Games Ministers are encouraged to host activities at Social and Baronial events and are supported if they choose to pursue hosting medieval game nights.

Other duties include:

- a. Maintain, and inventory the Baronial game supply.
- b. Provide the updated inventory to the Steward in January.

Golden Dragon Pursuivant (Herald): Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Owain!

The Herald acts as the voice of the Crown and of the Crown's Representatives, the Coronet. The Dragon's Laire Baronial Herald uses the title of Golden Dragon Pursuivant. This is a Kingdom Warranted position, which is required to send quarterly reports to a designated Kingdom Officer.

a) Provide heraldic services to the Barony including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry. The Baronial Herald is not required to be an expert in all areas but should know who to call upon to provide the services.

You can also speak with the Marquesa Laurellen about any position or consider asking about becoming a Deputy!

M'Lord Kamar (MKA Raymond Hicks) volunteered the use of an Industrial Sewing Machine for the manufacture of Canvas Bags in which to store Baronial Owned Equipment. New Business

Fearghus MacCulloch:

<u>Proposal</u>: To change Section 4.03 (b) of the Customary of the Barony of Dragon's Laire to allow deputy marshals for all martial activities supported by the Barony to reside outside of the geographic boundaries of the Barony.

<u>Background</u>: The issue of whether the proposed Canton of Misty Ridge can hold official martial practices or not continues to arise. The Governing Documents of the SCA, The Seneschal's Handbook, the Marshal's handbook, and the Kingdom of An Tir Handbook address events held by official branches of the SCA.

<u>Conclusion</u>: If the Customary is changed to allow deputy marshals of Baronial martial activities to reside outside of the Barony's borders, members of the proposed Canton could be appointed as deputy marshals. This would allow the Barony to hold official practices in the proposed Canton that could be run by local members and be covered by the SCA practices within the proposed Canton during its incipient stage. Kingdom approval of this plan would need to be obtained.

Summary of Remarks:

There was an extended discussion which resulted in the attending Populace agreeing that they were in support of pursuing an update that would allow official activities to occur in Jefferson and Clallam Counties under the auspices of the Barony of Dragon's Laire, including Marshals but also other roles such as Arts & Sciences or Herald to encourage additional activities.

Steps that need to occur:

- Discussion with the Kingdom Seneschal to see if the proposed change would be approved.
- Terminology as many Baronial Officer Marshal positions are already officially Deputies of the Baronial Marshal.
- Update the Customary and Appendix 1
