We intend to continue this program and encourage the Sergeants to engage with our wider Populace to not only spread inspiration but also promote the SCA as an active, participatory pursuit. Future event teams and officers must understand that they are, today, an integral and valued part of the Barony. Our events, activities, and daily business are planned and conducted by us all – there is no "them" here.

We believe that the foundation of the role of the Coronet is to guide and encourage the Populace – the whole Populace – toward The Dream in its many forms. We hope to serve and represent Dragon's Laire as Baron and Baroness, but even if we do not, we will continue to serve the Barony and the Kingdom as proud members of Dragon's Laire, An Tir, and this great Society.
