



1. IN STRVTIONE

[6.1.1] **in strutione elixo:** piper mentam Cuminum assum apii semen dactilos mel carcotas mel acetum passum liquamen et oleum modice, et in caccabo facies et bulliat, amulo obliges, et sic partes strutionis inlance perfundis, et desuper piper aspargis, si autem in condituram coquere uloueris, aliacam addis.

BOOK SIX OF THE SAME, 'FOWL', BEGINS

6.1 SAUCES FOR OSTRICH

6.1.1 Sauce for boiled ostrich; pepper, mint, roasted cumin, celery seed, long or round dates, honey, vinegar, *passum*, *liquamen* and a little oil. Put in a pan and bring to the boil. Thicken it with starch and in this state pour over the peies of ostrich on a serving dish and sprinkle with pepper. If however you want to cook (the ostrich) in the sauce then add *alica*.

Recipe Notes:

- Doing some research, ostrich is available but spendy. The closest equivalent is a lean cut of beef.
- Passum is a type of sweet, 'straw wine' which is delicious and made with a native grape. Moscato is a US straw wine made with a different species of grape but a tasty sweet equivalent although likely to have a slightly different flavor profile.
- Town & Country in Poulsbo has all of these spices in bulk so you can get only the amount you need and not pay for an extra bottle to recycle.

Redaction:

1-2 lbs of beef loin, cleaned

Season with salt and pepper, roast to just shy of preferred doneness, at least 145.

Ragoût

1 Tbsp cumin seed

1 tsp celery seed

1 tsp peppercorns

300 ml Moscato (1/2 bottle)

3-4 candied dates, pitted and diced

3 tbsp fish sauce or 50g tin of anchovies

2 tbsp chopped mint

1 tsp honey

3 tbsp strong vinegar

1 tbsp neutral oil

1-2 tbsp flour (optional, may not be needed)

- 1. In a small skillet, toast the cumin, peppercorns, and celery seeds until fragrant, transfer to a plate to cool. Grind in a spice grinder or mortar and pestle.
- 2. Using the same skillet or a sauce pot
 - 3. If you are using the anchovies, heat the skillet to medium, add 1 tbsp of oil, heat, and add the anchovies, breaking them up gently.
 - 4. Add the wine, spices, dates, vinegar and honey, stirring to incorporate
 - 5. Turn the heat to simmer, stirring occasionally as everything melds. The dates should 'melt' into the sauce
 - 6. Add the mint, stir, simmer for 1-2 minutes
 - 7. Taste to adjust salt and pepper, optionally add garlic

M'Lord Kamar (MKA Raymond Hicks) volunteered the use of an Industrial Sewing Machine for the manufacture of Canvas Bags in which to store Baronial Owned Equipment. If you have equipment, or time, you can donate for this cause, please contact Her Excellency Kloe. Susan Levitt purchased new rope. Reimbursement for supplies and a one-time travel allowance approved by the DLFC on 04/12/2021 to Susan Levitt. What is next for the project? Left to purchase: poles and pins, and stakes. Hold on acquiring poles due to the increased cost of lumber. Focus on acquiring stakes. Needs physical help to assess tents and number of stakes needed. David Meyers (AKA Thangbrandr) to submit a bid for pole pins and tent stakes. Approved. Reimbursement made 02/01/22. Dining fly poles bid - Lucy Submitted bid for poles. Approved for purchase of materials. Waiting for reimbursement request. Bag project will re-visit after June Faire. Tent bag project to be taken over by Amanda Zeitler (AKA HE Kloe of Thira) Baroness is requesting funds. Supplies have been received. Waiting for Receipts to reconcile the cash advice. Now waiting for finished bags. In process.
