'Summer Compote of Pears'

Chomposte da state di pere: Delicate vivande, Recipe 83
From the Art of Cookery in the Middle Ages by Terrance Scully

Redacted by Ciar ingen Fiachnae, October 2014

One of the very first recipes Maenach and I ever redacted.

I did some poking around on the internet because I didn't really know what I was doing and came across a feast that used the same recipe in 2000 and provided their redaction, you can still find it using the <u>Wayback Machine</u>.

We did this recipe a total of three times, the first two times were to test technique, the third for the actual meeting. I tend to view recipes as conversations, apologies in advance for the slight chatty notes.

Summer Compote of Pears from "Chomposte da state di pere: Delicate vivande, Recipe 83." From "The Art of Cookery in the Middle Ages" by Terence Scully, page 229.

Get Ruggine pears or some other sort of pears that are hard and good enough, and cook them a little; get carrots and parsley leaves, celery hearts [chorone d'appio] and parsnips [pastricciani], and if you cannot get all of these, get whatever you can; cook them enough; get dates and prunes - that is, susine, whether these are bitter or dry - and cook them a little; when everything is cooked, let it cool; get mustard seed, ground and moistened in good white wine with which is mixed a little vinegar, and add in honey, sugar, anise and beaten fennel, and a little horseradish; then put the pears and everything else you have cooked in the pot or in some other container in which you wish to keep them; and make a layer, then cover it with that mixture you have made, and so, layer by layer, put in everything; then keep it covered and it will turn out good.

Summer Compote of Pears

3-4 red D'Anjou pears (they are tasty and in season, total 1/2 lb)

2 celery stalks

2 carrots (we used heritage purple because I like them

2 parsnips

1/8 bunch fresh parsley

1/8 lb prunes

1/8 pound dates

1/4 cup cider vinegar*

1/8 cup honey

1/2 tsp sugar

1/2 tsp mustard seed

1/4 tsp anise seed

1/4 tsp fennel seed

1/4 tsp horseradish (bought fresh, grated)

*This should actually be 1/8 cup white wine (we used apple during the experiment, was tasty) and 1/8 cup cider vinegar but we were out of wine.

Parboil pears and veggies until you can pierce with a fork; carryover cooking will get you from pierce-with-a-fork to easily-pierced-with-a-fork. Chop the prunes and dates.

Grind the mustard seed and anise. Crush the fennel seed. Grate the horse-radish. Combine the (wine), vinegar, honey, sugar, and spices. Add in the chopped prunes and dates. Add more vinegar if your liquid becomes to gellike after re-hydrating the dried fruits.

Finely dice your parsley; this is to your taste. We started with the half bunch as recommended in the feast recipe and then dropped to a quarter. We felt it still added too much "green" taste and amplified the sort of "mint" taste from the parsnips to the detriment of the rest of the dish.

Chop pears and veggies into similar sized pieces. Layer pear-veggie mixture, sauce, and parsley. Repeat. Cover and let sit overnight. On the third time making this, we mixed everything together, no layers, let it sit overnight, and didn't notice any difference in taste or presentation.

Further notes: This ends up fairly sweet, I would probably increase the horse-radish, audience depending. I also didn't end up caring for the prune/date mix and would likely replace them with currants and raisins

- h. Request for funds to purchase signs to use during Baronial Courts to help announce awards. ~\$110 Approved.
 - i. A&S Day \$200 Security deposit to become donation to the church approved. Figure out how to get the check to Karl
- j. YAC requesting reimbursement for boffer making items; large pool noodle, helmet repair kits (two options), gorilla glue, close cell mat, jacks, jills, and jock straps. (approved)
- k. Printing one handbook, 20 waivers per tourney. (add to budget annually) (approved)
- l. YAC Materials to make signs for YAC plywood, outdoor paint. Instead, use materials on hand to fit for modular use (approved)
- m. Web-team: request to move domain name and hosting to new providers. Increase capacity and reduce cost. (approved)
- n. Storage unit: too much stuff, safety hazard. Barony items dispersed across numerous homes. Could we have June Faire stuff in a second smaller storage unit? not really (approved). Storage unit prices have doubled, so this is now on hold.
- o. Request for Rebar to use to erect barriers for fighting: Arion. Approved up to \$300. Additional material cost \$21.39.

- p. Request for materials to make 10 portable holes: Arion. Estimated expense: \$65.
- q. Request \$110 for supplies and materials for use of Thangbrand's shop.
- r. Request to allow \$20 per month allowance for digital communication functionality; options will be explored by the Web team.

- g. Replace [Kingdom Exchequer] with [former Kingdom Exchequer] who is currently a signer on the accounts. Nikippa needs to set a date(s) with the Bank for all signers (current and new) to get new signature cards.
- h. Signers should be going to the bank to sign their cards. Once all new and existing signers have signed, we can move forward with the new signers. Nikippa is coordinating with Elewyn Verch Emrys to come to Kitsap to sign as Kingdom representative.
- i. Nikippa attended Exchequer training in May. She learned that she incorrectly deposited the gate seed money with the proceeds from Ostara and Beltane. These monies were NOT counted as event profit in any reports, but she is clarifying for the financial meeting minutes that the deposit tickets to the bank for Ostara and Beltane contained the gate seed return deposits. Gate seed was \$150 for each event.

- 5. Long Term Maintenance Agenda Items (Maintained on this agenda until resolved):
- a. Purchase of three Baronial Day Shades- Amanda Zeitler (AKA HE Kloe of Thira)
- i. Purchase of three Baronial Day Shades: Canvas was received in June. Poles, ropes, and stakes to be manufactured / acquired and Day Shades assembled for storage. Her Excellency Kloe is managing this effort at the moment. Several people volunteered to assist in this work. M'Lord Kamar (MKA Raymond Hicks) volunteered the use of an Industrial Sewing Machine for the manufacture of Canvas Bags in which to store Baronial Owned Equipment. If you have equipment, or time, you can donate for

this cause, please contact Her Excellency Kloe. Susan Levitt purchased new rope. Reimbursement for supplies and a one-time travel allowance approved by the DLFC on 04/12/2021 to Susan Levitt. Needs physical help to assess tents and number of stakes needed. David Meyers (AKA Thangbrandr) to submit a bid for pole pins and tent stakes. Approved. Reimbursement made 02/01/22. Dining fly poles bid - Lucy Submitted bid for poles. Approved for purchase of materials. Waiting for reimbursement request. Bag project will re-visit after June Faire. Tent bag project to be taken over by Amanda Zeitler (AKA HE Kloe of Thira) Baroness is requesting funds. Supplies have been received. Waiting for Receipts to reconcile the cash advice. Now waiting for finished bags. In process
