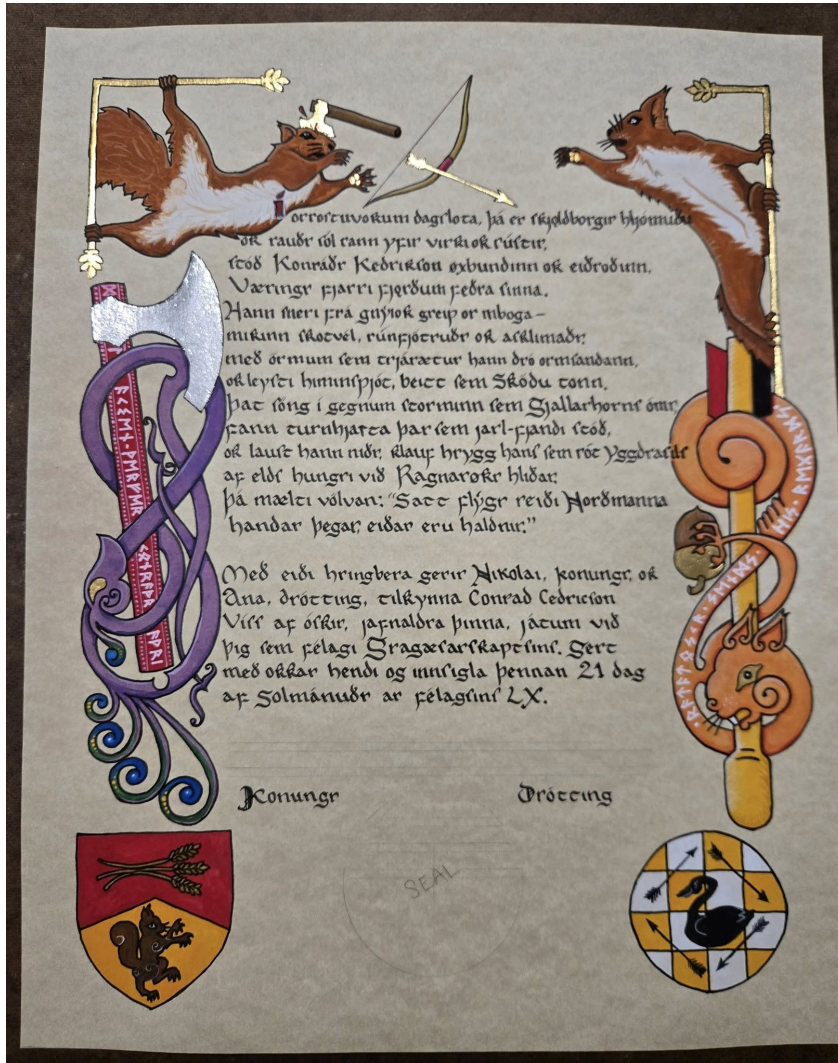

“Mushroom Pierogi”

Dough recipe provided by Rycheza z Polska, source: Family

Filling recipe redacted by Halldora Bjorn

Basic Dough

Instructions from Halldora Bjorn

2 cups flour

2 eggs

1/2 teaspoon salt (non-iodized)

1/3 cup warm water

To make the dough:

In a food processor, add flour, salt, and eggs, pulse a few times. Then slowly stream in 1/3 cup of water until a ball forms.

Remove dough and knead a few times on a lightly floured surface until smooth. Then cut dough into quarters and wrap in plastic wrap. Let rest in the fridge for 10-20 minutes.

While dough rests, prepare the fillings.

After dough has chilled, roll out on a lightly floured surface into a rectangle or circle as thin as possible (try to be less than a 1/4 inch thick). A pasta roller can also be used (try to get to #4 thickness).

Use a 3” diameter cup or round cookie cutter to cut out circles. Re-use scraps to roll out at the end.

Place about a Tablespoon of filling in the center of the circle. Dip your finger in water and run along the edge of the circle to help seal the dumplings. Fold dough in half to form a semi-circle. Seal the ends with your fingers and use a fork to crimp them close. Place pierogies on a parchment lined baking sheet while you finish the rest.

Once the pierogis are made, they can be cooked immediately in boiling salted water or frozen on trays in a single layer for storage. Once frozen, pierogis can be placed in a plastic bag on top of each other.

To cook pierogies, boil about 4-5 filled pierogies at a time. The water doesn't have to be at a rolling boil, but a light boil. You know they are ready when pierogies float to the top.

Mushroom Pierogi filling

1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil

1/2 large sweet onion, diced

2 tablespoons unsalted butter

16 ounces cremini mushrooms, minced (use food processor or grinder)

salt (non-iodized) and ground pepper

2 cloves garlic, minced

1/4 cup fresh chopped parsley or 1Tb Dried

1 tablespoon fresh thyme or 1 tsp dried

3 ounces cream cheese

1/4 cup bread crumbs

In a large skillet, heat the oil over medium heat. Add the onions, reduce heat to low, and cook, stirring occasionally, until they become translucent, 4-5 minutes.

Add the butter to the pan and heat until melted. Add the mushrooms to the pan and cook, stirring frequently, until they release their moisture and begin to soften, 6-8 minutes. Season the mixture with salt and pepper, and continue to cook until the mixture has browned, 8-10 minutes more.

Add the garlic, parsley and thyme and stir to combine. Cook until fragrant, 1-2 minutes more.

Stir in the cream cheese until melted. Stir in the bread crumbs, and simmer until the mixture thickens slightly. Season with salt and pepper to taste.

Let mixture cool before using as filling.

The Story of Melkorka

Karl inn irski, background and a re-telling

The history of Iceland is revealed in a wealth of written works, including 20+ Sagas, the Eddas (the Poetic Edda and the Prose Edda), the Landnámabók (Book of Settlements), and the Íslendingabók (Book of Icelanders). This article focuses on information from the Landnámabók and one of the Sagas, the Laxdæla saga.

My persona name, Karl inn irski, means 'Karl Irish' or 'Karl from Ireland' in 10th century Icelandic. My persona was inspired by the story of Melkorka, a story primarily found in the Laxdæla saga, with information from the Landnámabók providing confirmation of historical existence and of her lineage.

This is my retelling of the story, based on information from the above sources. The story takes place in 10th century Iceland (the Laxdæla saga was written ~300 years later).

People in the story:

- Melkorka, sold as a slave to Hoskuld, has a child fathered by Hoskuld
- Koll, Hoskuld's father
- Hoskuld, son of Koll, bodyguard to the King of Norway, married to Jorunn
- Jorunn, wife of Hoskuld, not a fan of Melkorka
- Olaf, Melkorka's son fathered by Hoskuld

Koll arrives in Iceland in 895 CE, traveling with a group of people from Norway, marries, and sets up a household. His son is named Hoskuld. When Koll passes away, Hoskuld inherits the land and house. He becomes a bodyguard to King Hakon of Norway and is well-known in Iceland and Norway, spending part of the year in each country. He marries Jorunn in 935 CE, and they have several children.

During a trading expedition to Norway, Hoskuld purchases a thrall-woman (who is thought to be mute) from a Rus merchant on Brännö (an island in the Southern Göteborg Archipelago, Sweden). He spends 3 silvers, even though the expected price for a thrall-woman is 1 silver. The woman he purchases is Melkorka. He brings Melkorka with him when he returns home to Iceland in 948 CE.

Jorunn (Hoskuld's wife), although annoyed, is willing to have Melkorka in the household. Hoskuld is faithful to his wife once he has returned to Iceland. However, Melkorka is pregnant and has a son, named Olaf. Of course, as is expected in these kinds of tales, Olaf was noble-looking and precocious. Now that Melkorka has a son obviously fathered by Hoskuld, Jorunn is unhappier, and demands that Melkorka work or go away. Hoskuld decides that Melkorka should wait on them and take care of Olaf.

When Olaf was around 4 years old, Hoskuld overhears someone talking down by the brook on the property. He finds out that Melkorka is not mute but is talking to her son in Gaelic. Hoskuld confronts her, saying it was useless to hide that she could speak. She tells him her name and says that she is the daughter of the Irish king, that she was taken as a prisoner of war at age 15.

When Hoskuld informs his wife about these new developments, there isn't any immediate reaction, but shortly thereafter squabbles erupted, with Jorunn striking Melkorka with stockings and Melkorka punching Jorunn and bloodying her nose. Hoskuld was forced to move Melkorka to her own farm (Melkorkastad) with Olaf. Again, as we'd expect, Olaf grew to be handsome, courteous, and intelligent.

Melkorka didn't want her son to be known as the son of a slave-woman, so she struck a bargain that she would marry a trader if the trader would support Olaf in a trading expedition. Before Olaf departed, Melkorka gave him a gold finger ring, telling him that it had been a gift from her father, the king.

Olaf (now 18 years old) arrives in Norway and was received by King Harald. The king's mother took an interest in Olaf and helped outfit a ship so that Olaf could get to Ireland

and visit his kin. The ship was crewed with 60 men, many of whom were warriors.

The voyage was extremely difficult, with storms, fog, then lack of wind. They found themselves adrift off the shore of Ireland, and the local Irish (according to their laws) wanted to take the ship and trade goods as flotsam. Olaf donned his armor and had his men line the rails holding spears and shields. The Irish locals, who had been heading out to the ship, decided to retreat and call for the king, since one warship probably meant that others were in the area.

The king arrives, and to tie up the story, they talk and Olaf uses the ring to prove that he is the king's grandson, and everyone celebrates and is happy. The king offers to make Olaf his heir (as the king isn't very happy with his own sons) but Olaf declines and travels back to Norway, then to Iceland.
