“Harmless Salad”

Apicius XVIII (3.18.2): INTVBAE ET LACTVCAE

lactucas: cum oxyporio et aceto et modico liquamine ad digestionem et inflationem et ne lactucae ledant: cumini uncias II; gengiber unciam I; rutae uiridis unciam I; dactilorum pinguium scripulos XII; pipersi unciam I; mellis uncais VIII, cuminum aut Aethiopicum aut Siriacum aut Libicum. tundes cuminum et postea infundes in aceto. cum siccauerit postea melle omnia conprehendes; cum necesse fuerit dimidium coclearum <cum> aceto et liquamine modico misces aut post cenam dimidium coclearum accipies.

3.18 ENDIVE AND LETTUCE

3.18.2 Lettuce (serve) with an *oxyporium*, with vinegar and a little *liquamen* for the digestion and to ease wind and to prevent the lettuce from doing harm: 2 oz. cumin, 1 oz. ginger, 1 oz. green rue, 12 scruples date flesh, 1 oz. pepper, 9 oz. honey, Ethiopian, Syrian, or Libyan cumin. Pound the cumin after you have steeped it in vinegar. When it has dried mix all the ingredients with the honey*. When required mix 1/2 teaspoon with the vinegar and a little liquamen or take 1/2 teaspoon after dinner.

*This means soak the cumin seeds in vinegar, let them dry, pound them, and then combine to make the concoction. Then, when you're ready to dress the greens, mix the concoction with vinegar and a little liquamen. Or consume 1/2 teaspoon after you have eaten the meal.

“Make Salad Harmless” Dressing

Redacted by Ciar ingen Fiachnae

The recipe creates an *oxyporum* (loosely translated, a digestive) that you then combine a portion of with additional vinegar and fish sauce in order to dress salad greens. The ingredients counter the humoral effects of the salad greens to put or keep you in balance.

For a small amount to combine into a salad dressing today:

1/4 cup vinegar (your choice, I’ve used white wine, red wine, apple cider, and balsamic)

1/2 tsp fish sauce

1 tsp honey

6 peppercorns or 1/4 tsp ground pepper (black, white, or longpepper)

1 tsp cumin seed or 3/4 tsp ground cumin

1/4 tsp ground ginger OR 1/2 tsp freshly grated ginger

1 date, seed removed, roughly chopped

6-8 flat-leaf parsley, washed, and finely chopped

Fancy prep using whole spices: Toast your dry pepper and cumin. Combine in mortar and pestle or spice grinder, grind. Mix with dried ginger if using.

1. Using a small sauce pan, put the vinegar, honey, and fish sauce over low heat. Stir gently to combine. Add the date, continue to stir, it should start to melt.
2. Add the ground spices, ginger, and parsley. Remove from the heat, scrapping down the sides.
3. Let sit until you’re ready to use.
4. Strain the mixture through a sieve or cheese cloth. You can put it into bowl so individuals can drizzle themselves or drizzle over a bowl of prepared greens in large bowl.

Greens: herbs, dark leafy greens, carrot tops, beet tops, spinach etc. Romaine would be okay, Iceberg is not.

OFFICERS WANTED

Games Minister: Looking for a Step-up Deputy, please speak with HL Lucy!

It is the responsibility of the Games Minister to promote, teach, and support the practice of playing medieval games and pastimes. Games Ministers are encouraged to host activities at Social and Baronial events and are supported if they choose to pursue hosting medieval game nights.

Other duties include:

- a. Maintain, and inventory the Baronial game supply.
- b. Provide the updated inventory to the Steward in January.
- a) Provide heraldic services to the Barony including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry. The Baronial Herald is not required to be an expert in all areas but should know who to call upon to provide the services.

Golden Dragon Pursuivant (Baronial Herald)

The Herald acts as the voice of the Crown and of the Crown's Representatives, the Coronet. The Dragon's Laire Baronial Herald uses the title of Golden Dragon Pursuivant. This is a Kingdom Warranted position, which is required to send quarterly reports to a designated Kingdom Officer.

- a) Provide heraldic services to the Barony including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry. The Baronial Herald is not required to be an expert in all areas but should know who to call upon to provide the services.

They are also responsible for fostering the practice of period arts and sciences within the Barony, including participation in the Dragon's Laire Scholars Program. Duties include:

- a) Organize and support the annual Arts & Sciences presentation and Championships, Bardic presentations and Championships, and Scholars program presentations.
- b) Schedule and oversee A&S play days, which are typically held in April and late October/early November.
- c) Organize and support A&S and Bardic activities at other Baronial events and Socials.
- d) Recruit and support deputies to assist with tasks and projects as well as the Games Minister position.

Duties and responsibilities are described in the An Tir Book of Target, the An Tir Book of Combat, and the SCA Marshal's Handbook. If archery via horseback occurs, the An Tir Book of Horse must also be consulted.

- (a) Run the weekly archery practice for both long and short range, coordinating with Baronial archery marshals to ensure appropriate coverage.
- (b) Maintain Baronial loaner gear in appropriate condition and supply annual inventory to Baronial Steward as requested.
- (c) Submit scores in a timely manner and by deadlines set by Kingdom and Society.
- (d) Make monthly reports at the Baronial business meeting and submit quarterly reports to the Kingdom Deputy Marshal for Archery.

Youth Armored Combat Marshal (Deputy)

The Youth Armored Combat Officer is responsible for the conduct of Society-legal youth-armored combat as described in the Society and Kingdom YAC Manuals.

- a) Successfully apply for and pass a Society background check and complete An Tir YAC Marshall training to become at least a Junior Marshall.
- b) Run YAC practices.
- c) Promote and support YAC activities at Baronial events and Baronial sponsored Kingdom Events.

- e) Make monthly reports at the Baronial business meeting and submit quarterly reports to the Kingdom Deputy Marshal for Youth Armored Combat and Baronial Marshall.

March is Women's History Month. Throughout history there are stories of women who did great things. Boudica, Cleopatra, Joan of Arc, Timoclea, Elizabeth I just to name a few. Take a moment this month and tell a woman you know how much you appreciate her.

The end of the month also brings us International Transgender Day of Visibility. The SCA is welcoming of all gender identities and presentations. Our trans members enrich our game and are valued for who they are and the unique perspective they bring. I am happy that the SCA, and our Barony is a welcoming place for them. If anyone, for any reason, doesn't feel welcome or valued for the unique individual they are please reach out to me and I'll do my best to help you find your place and people within the Barony.

As we look at sites for events we need to think of accessibility as more than just accessibility for disabilities. Accessibility can also be an issue with other marginalized communities who may not feel safe in some spaces. Those with religious trauma or who are repeatedly discriminated by religious institutions (LGBT+, pagan based faiths, Muslims) may not feel comfortable attending events held at religious places such as churches. While a site might be a safe space the area around the site may not be. This is an issue with Gulf War which is held in Mississippi. Many BIPOC and LGBT+ SCAdians have expressed concern about going to Gulf Wars due to the racisms and bias in the South. While they may feel safe on site, they don't feel safe going into town to get supplies or seeking medical attention if needed.

While most sites along the I-5 corridor are usually pretty safe, sites on the eastern side of the Cascades can feel unsafe to some marginalized communities. While we can't hold all events on the west side we can help our friends feel safe by offering to ride with them or go with them when they need to do a supply run. Be aware of your privilege and use it to help others.

Monthly Canton Marshal's Report for the Incipient Canton of Misty Ridge, Marshal Fearghus MacCulloch, submitted March 2, 2026:

The Incipient Canton has two marshals, one in target archery and one in heavy weapons. Target archery is still the only martial activity that holds practices on a regular basis.
